

Working with street children and families in Sihanoukville, Cambodia since 2003

Although poverty rates are falling in Cambodia, many families continue to struggle. There are still almost <u>3 million poor people and over 8.1 million who are near-poor</u>.

M'Lop Tapang currently works with more than 4,000 vulnerable or disadvantaged children and youth, but it is not always about working with the children directly. Often it is about helping mothers and fathers with what they need to fulfill their roles as parents and to be better able to provide for their own families needs.

For some of the parents that we work, finding a safe place for their children when they go to work is a real challenge. The Baby Care program at our neighborhood Community Shelter provides day time care so that parents can access employment.

### Safer Homes

#### Assisting with House Repairs



Understanding that providing a safe environment for their children to grow up in is also important, the Outreach team collaborates with local families on urgently needed house repairs.

So far this year with your support we have helped 56 poor families with much needed house repairs.

## Learning and Sharing

#### Family meetings and support groups



New this year is a regularly scheduled support group for parents of children in the <u>Special Needs Class</u>. Modeled after our <u>Alcohol Support Group</u>, the support group provides parents with an opportunity to share and learn from each other.



M'Lop Tapang, a local nonprofit organization registered with the Royal Government of Cambodia, has been working with disadvantaged children in Sihanoukville since 2003.

We currently work with over 4000 children and 1500 families in the Sihanoukville area providing shelter, medical care, sports and arts, education and training, counseling, family support and protection from all types of abuse.
